The Royal International Air Tattoo 2026 will attract over 180,000 people over three days from Friday 17th to Sunday 19th July 2026, in the glorious Cotswolds at RAF Fairford.

For over 50 years, RIAT has been delivering the ultimate airshow experience. Attendees enjoy spectacular views of the air displays and a vibrant showground including shopping, food and drink, and captivating activities. Under the theme 'Fighter Meet', RIAT26 will spotlight a century of air-to-air combat aircraft from classic warbirds to cutting edge modern fighters.

First held in 1971, RIAT has a worldwide reputation for aviation excellence and STEM promotion. Staged in aid of the Royal Air Force Charitable Trust, RIAT is supported by the Royal Air Force (RAF) and the United States Air Force (USAF). The RAF provides significant support through the provision of the Ministry of Defence estate, RAF personnel and equipment. The USAF also provides invaluable assistance by allowing the Air Tattoo to be staged at RAF Fairford.



REVAMPING RIAT

In 2026, RIAT begins an exciting program to revamp the showground experience. We are enhancing the showground look and feel, improving wayfinding and creating thematic zones that link static aircraft displays with featured attractions - The RAF Experience, Techno Zone and hospitality enclosures. 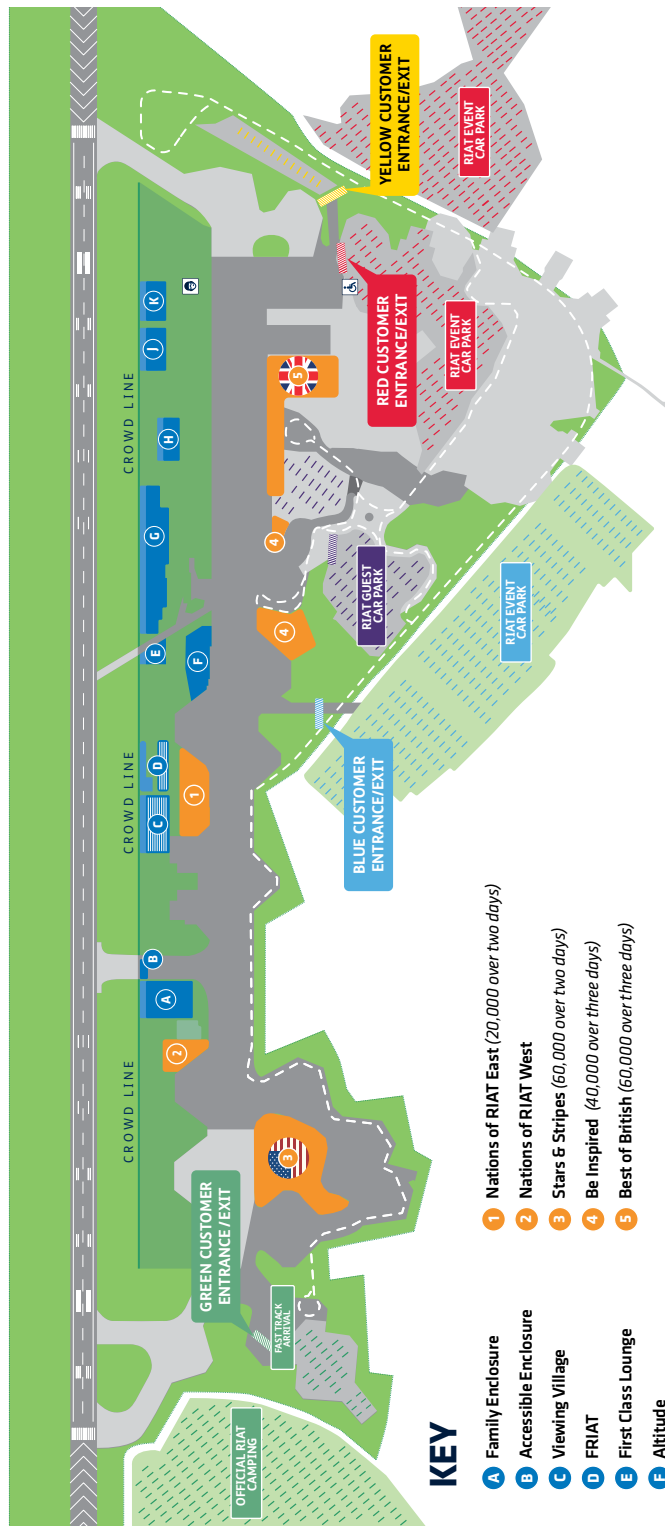

KEY INFORMATION

GENERAL

- All prices quoted are exclusive of VAT which will be charged at the prevailing rate.
- All measurements are in metres.
- Most trading will be located within pre-built tentage (canvas structure with metal frame), Exemptions will be made for suitable trailer units which meet set criteria. This will be reviewed on an individual enquiry basis
- All vehicles will be parked in the Green Cone road car parks, located on the showground. No vehicles are permitted to park next to their trading location except additional BOH space has been purchased. Vehicle access to your trading location will be available pre-show opening and post-show closing Friday to Sunday (inclusive).

TRADING GUIDELINES

- Product displays to be well organised, clearly laid out, and kept neat and tidy during show times
- Maintain high standards of merchandising throughout RIAT
- Be respectful and engage positively, creating a welcoming and enjoyable environment.
- Maintain a smart and professional appearance throughout RIAT
- Confirmed bookings will receive a Traders Welcome Pack, with further information and example images of favourable merchandise displays.



KEY INFORMATION

PROHIBITED ACTIVITY

- Any market-style trading. No hawking, loud vocal encouragement or activity deemed unsuitable to RIAT
- Displaying items outside of your trading pitch. This includes in front, to the side and overhead. In addition, you should not cover the signage or fascia that we put up above your trading pitch
- Additional signage or flags outside or above your trading pitch. These will be removed if displayed
- Consuming food or drink within your trading pitch in view of visitors
- Canvassing for business outside of your trading pitch
- It is strictly forbidden for anyone to sleep in their vehicles or stand on the base. Armed security and guard dogs are on patrol

CHARITIES

RIAT is staged in support of the Royal Air Force Charitable Trust. Whilst we welcome charitable traders on the showground, trading space is very limited.

All charitable enquiries need to be received by the 1st February 2026 for review against showground availability.



KEY INFORMATION

WI-FI & MOBILE CELLULAR CONNECTION

- Wi-Fi is available on the showground; however, it is very important to note that we cannot guarantee signal, due to the size and constraints of RAF Fairford, it is impossible to ensure a signal is available everywhere and signal will be affected by demand and usage
- Mobile phone signal is available on the showground, subject to excess use which can potentially affect signal strength. We rely on the major networks to provide signal; therefore, RIAT cannot guarantee signal and coverage
- It is prudent to consider the type of POS and digital equipment you are using, ensuring it is robust in terms of connectivity, as well as having the ability to connect to both Wi-Fi and mobile cellular (with the capacity to work across multiple cellular networks), as well as maintaining the ability for cash sales

SUSTAINABILITY

- We continue our commitment to make RIAT a more sustainable event by implementing and developing more sustainable ways of working. Submissions that can demonstrate a proactive approach to incorporating sustainable practices in their stalls will be given priority. Please ensure to include this information in your submissions
- You are required to dispose of your waste responsibly and where possible take it with you when leaving the showground. Waste and litter can be a danger to aircraft and the public
- In line with the Site Regulations, do not bring any single-use plastics onto the showground, particularly for freebies/giveaways. Please be aware that if you are found with single-use plastics on site you will be asked to remove them immediately
- Make use of the hydration stations to fill-up your reusable water bottles
- Consider your transport and where possible use as few vehicles as practicably possible

PROHIBITED EXHIBITS AND ARTICLES

The following items may not under any circumstance be brought onto the Airfield: any ammunition, flares, offensive weapons or parts thereof, including firearms and replica firearms (whether toy or otherwise), spent casings, ball-bearing guns, airguns, crossbows, catapults, lock-bladed knives, flick knives, butterfly knives and variations or knives of a non-domestic/practical use.

- **The following items may not under any circumstances be exhibited or offered for sale on the Airfield:**
 - i. Lighter than air balloons or similar devices
 - ii. Kites, remotely controlled powered model aircraft, drones or similar devices
 - iii. Any other item that the Organisers deem unsuitable or have notified to the Exhibitors as being unsuitable
- **The following shall only be permitted to be exhibited or offered for sale at the Airfield with the prior written authority of the Organisers:**
 - i. Any lottery raffle or gaming tickets
 - ii. Any type, or reproduction, of any RAFCT, RAFCTE, RIAT 2026, or Air Tattoo event publishing or merchandise
 - iii. Food stuffs, refreshments, beverages or tobacco products whether for consumption at RIAT 2026 or otherwise
 - iv. All selling and promotional activity by Exhibitors and Corporate supporters must be confined to their allotted pitch, hospitality chalet or enclosure, data collection, roving sales, collections or distribution of any kind are not permitted unless previously authorised in writing by the Organisers

Applications are assessed on their merits taking special considerations for the relevance of the products sold, the alignment of your products to our customers, our themed zones and your previous track record with RIAT26.
